The following aren't, "steps," as much as they're explanations of commitments to God that are essential if you are to become a child of God and know you have salvation.

AS GOD IS pure holiness, the basis of relationship with God is complete repentance from our sin. NO relationship with God can be begun while a person willfully and delightedly continues in sin.

Recognize that you are a sinner; you are separated from God by your sinful NATURE, which you cannot change, and for that reason you cannot earn your salvation by good works.

God's Word tells us that EVERYONE is a sinner. The Bible tells us that it is our SINFUL HEART that has separated us from God, from birth. For this reason, even if we were somehow able to change all our ACTIONS, so that we never again sinned outwardly, we would still be separated from God by our sinful NATURE, which we cannot change.

23 For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.

Romans 3:23

- $\boldsymbol{8}$  If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His Word Is not in us.

REALIZE THAT ONLY Jesus Christ, the sinless Son of God, is your means to God.

God's Word tells us that Jesus Christ, God's only Son, died on the cross in our place. Jesus, the only sinless Man ever born, took our sin upon Himself, and nailed that sin to the cross with Him, so that we might be sinless. Because He was, Himself, sinless, Jesus rose from the dead three days later, conquering death also, so that we, too, might have the right (with our sin destroyed by Jesus) to rise again to eternal life. Our eternal life was therefore bought and paid for by Jesus Christ (God Himself). No further work need be done (nor can be done) to earn our salvation; it was purchased by Jesus Christ Himself!

16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

17 For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

18 He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the Name of the only begotten Son of God.

REPENT OF YOUR Sins and ask God to forgive you of all sin you have committed, and to purify your sinful heart

Repentance is hating the sin we have committed, and making the commitment that, through the power of God, we will stop committing those sins. We ask God to help us hate the sins, and to help us stop committing the sins, because we can do neither on our own. And we do our part by making the decision. 19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the Lord.

Acts 3:19

These two acts are outward confessions of the inward decision that we have made. God knows that, "putting our money where our mouth is," is what makes our decision firm. Although they are outward acts, these are no less important in our decision to live for Christ, than the

inward decision that we have made. They are, in fact, the first

step forward in the wonderful life that you have just begun!
